ADMISSIONS POLICY & PROCEDURE

Welcome to the circle of excellence that we pursue at **MIDSTREAM SCHOOLS**.

You are requested to take note of the following:

- **MIDSTREAM COLLEGE** (grade 8 to 12) is an Independent High School, and **LAERSKOOL MIDSTREAM COLLEGE PRIMARY** and **LAERSKOOL MIDSTREAM RIDGE PRIMARY** (Grade 1 to 7) are Independent Primary Schools with their own admission requirements, being the same for both. Afrikaans and English are the two official languages of instruction.
- Admission will be considered, should there be space available in the particular grade. Preference will be given to learners who reside in Midstream Estates and/or attend one of the Midstream primary schools.
- Admission is not guaranteed and the admission process does not happen automatically between the Midstream high school and primary schools.

MIDSTREAM COLLEGE (MC):

1. The admission forms must be completed online in full.
2. When you submit the application form, a non-refundable registration fee of R500 per learner is payable.
3. Submit all the required signed documentation as listed on the Admissions landing page online with the application.
4. Learners will be scheduled for a compulsory admission test to ascertain the learner's academic ability. The test takes 1 hour 15 minutes.
5. The test will be marked.
6. **MC** may, if necessary, contact the learner's previous place of schooling with regard to credible information for admission purposes.
7. The school may schedule an interview with the prospective learner and parent at the schools' discretion.
8. Recommendations will be made and test results will be discussed with parents.
9. Acceptance will depend on the assessment results, the interview, what the learner can offer the College, as well as how the applicant can benefit from the College.
10. Results of this decision will be communicated to the parents by the end of June, after all the above have been adhered to.
11. The admission and enrolment of learners to **MC** is at the admission panel's discretion who may refuse a learner's admission to the College without giving reasons therefore. They may grant temporary or provisional enrolment to the College, subject to further terms and conditions which the panel may impose. The panel may, at their sole discretion, cancel enrolment in accordance with the rules.
12. Subject to clause 9, the writing of the test and submission of the application forms should not be interpreted as a warranty made by **MC** that a learner will be admitted to and enrolled at the College.

LAERSKOOL MIDSTREAM COLLEGE PRIMARY (LMCP) | LAERSKOOL MIDSTREAM RIDGE PRIMARY (LMRP)

1. The admission forms must be completed online in full.
2. When you submit the application form, a non-refundable registration fee of R400 per learner is payable.
3. Submit all the required signed documentation as listed on the admissions landing page online with the application.
4. Grade 2 to 7 learners will be scheduled for a compulsory placement test to ascertain the learner's academic ability. Grade 1 learners will be scheduled for an evaluation.
5. On successful completion of the placement test/evaluation, a decision will be made regarding the placement of children between the two primary schools.
6. The following factors will be taken into consideration when placements are made:
 - Siblings currently in the school.
 - Numbers in the grade.
7. Although every effort will be made to adhere to the above criteria, the school board and respective principals reserve the right to place learners at whichever school they deem fit, according to numbers prescribed and availability of space.
8. **LMCP | LMRP** may, if necessary, contact the learner's previous place of schooling with regards to credible information for admission purposes.
9. If required, the principal will schedule an interview with the prospective parents at their discretion. Recommendations will be made and test results will be discussed with parents.
10. Acceptance will depend on the placement test results, the interview as well as how the applicant can benefit from the school.
11. The writing of the placement test and submission of the application forms should NOT be interpreted as a warranty made by **LMCP | LMRP** that a learner will be admitted to and enrolled at the relevant school.
12. The admission and enrolment of learners to **LMCP | LMRP** is at the principal's discretion who may refuse a learner's admission to the school without providing a reason therefore. They may grant temporary or provisional enrolment to the school, subject to further terms and conditions which the principal may impose. The principal may, at their sole discretion, cancel enrolment in accordance with the rules.
