## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### MIDSTREAM COLLEGE (MC)

1. Completion of the online admission form confirms acceptance of the Terms and Conditions for admission to **MC**.
2. Consideration will be given to all applications.
3. Parents/guardians are requested to provide information on known disabilities of learners.
4. Learners, who are more than two years older than the average age of their grade, will not be considered for enrolment.
5. Completion of the online admission form implies that parents or guardians are aware:
  - of the Christian ethos of this College and agree that their child will abide by this and will attend assemblies.
  - that **MC** offers parallel medium tuition and the application for admission hereby submitted is for the English leg – as such all subjects (except Afrikaans) will be taught in English.
  - that the Code of Conduct of **MC** is accepted and underwritten.
  - that all learners will be expected to participate in at least one summer and one winter sport or cultural activity offered at the College.
  - that by enrolling your child, parents/guardians commit themselves to accept the decisions of the principal regarding College organisation and discipline.
  - that all complaints regarding rules, regulations, aims, policies, procedures or the application thereof, must be directed to the principal.
  - that learners are expected to attend all official school days including camps, special days and evenings which the College deems compulsory.
  - Parents/guardians give permission that images may be taken of their child and used for publication purposes (including but not limited to printed, digital and social media).
  - Parents/guardians understand that personal information of parents and learners is kept in digital and/or hardcopy format, and that this information may be processed for specific and legitimate reasons relating to the functions or activities of the school. Parents and learners have the right of access to personal information that was requested and they have the right to request such information be rectified.
  - Consent is given that personal information may be retained for a period as deemed necessary by the school and may be used for communication, advertising, marketing, historical, statistical or research purposes.
  - Consent is given to receive direct marketing of school related goods and services by means of electronic communication, including but not limited to e-mail, SMS and WhatsApp.

### LAERSKOOL MIDSTREAM COLLEGE PRIMARY (LMCP) | LAERSKOOL MIDSTREAM RIDGE PRIMARY (LMRP)

Completion of the online form and signing of the documents implies that both biological parents/guardians are aware and agree to the following:

1. The school maintains a Christian ethos. Each day and assemblies are opened with scripture reading and prayer.
2. Consideration will be given to all applications from learners with physical or emotional difficulties, following the completion of an evaluation of the learner and taking available facilities at **LMCP | LMRP** into consideration. Parents/guardians are requested to provide information on known disabilities, health conditions or learning difficulties with the application for admission.
3. Should your child be referred for an educational assessment by a doctor, psychologist, occupational or speech therapist whilst attending **LMCP | LMRP**, parents/guardians are requested to share the recommendations with the school. All reports will be treated in a confidential manner.
4. Learners, who are two years older than the average age of their grade, will not be considered for enrolment.
5. All physically capable learners in age groups above grade 1 will be expected to participate in at least one summer and one winter sport or cultural activity offered at the relevant school.
6. The non-interest-bearing deposit of R10 000 can be transferred to **MC** should the learner be accepted, and is only refundable should the learner leave at the end of a full school year, with a term's notice.
7. By enrolling their child, parents/guardians commit themselves to accept the decisions of the principal regarding school organisation and discipline.
8. The Code of Conduct of **LMCP | LMRP** is accepted and underwritten.
9. Learners are expected to attend all official schooldays, including school camps/tours, special days and evenings which the school deems compulsory.
10. Expenses towards individual items (tuition/coaching/training, etc.) as requested or authorised by the parents/guardians, will be charged to the learner's account.
11. Parents/guardians hereby take note of and give permission for the following:
  - That personal information of parents and learners is kept in digital or hard copy format and will only be processed for specific and legitimate reasons relating to the functions or activities of the school. Parents and learners have the right of access to, and the right to rectify personal information that was requested.
